

REQUIREMENTS FOR PLAN REVIEW

HOMEOWNERS AND **CONTRACTORS**

AS OF JUNE 1, 1999, ALL RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL PLANS **MUST** BE SUBMITTED TO THE BUILDING DEPARTMENT PRIOR TO OBTAINING YOUR BUILDING PERMIT.

ALL PLANS MUST BE LEGIBLE:

RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL PLANS **MUST** HAVE THE FOLLOWING:

- 1) PLOT PLAN
- 2) FLOOR PLAN
- 3) FOUNDATION AND FOOTING PLAN
- 4) ELECTRICAL PLAN
- 5) MECHANICAL PLAN
- 6) PLUMBING DRAIN LAYOUT PLAN
- 7) ENERGY CODE COMPLIANCE CERTIFICATION

COMMERCIAL PLANS **MUST** BE APPROVED BY THE STATE FIRE MARSHALL BEFORE THEY ARE SUBMITTED TO THE BUILDING DEPARTMENT.

THE APPROVED SET OF PLANS **MUST** BE ON THE JOBSITE AT ALL TIMES DURING THE INSPECTION PROCEDURES.
