Ascension Parish Storm Damage Locations/Road Closures Confirmed

PRAIRIEVILLE – Ascension Parish Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness officials confirmed residences and structures in the Prairieville area sustained damage from winds caused by a strong weather system that passed through the parish this morning.

Damage locations confirmed at this time in the Prairieville area include Hwy. 930 at Balmoral Street, Hwy. 930 at Henry Street, Hwy. 930 at Daigle Road, Park Book Street in Southwood Village Subdivision off of Hwy. 73, and Oakleigh Street in the Silverstone Subdivision off of Hwy. 73.

Emergency preparedness officials confirmed road closure locations at this time include West Lane, Hwy. 930 at Hwy. 42, Parker Road at Akins Road, Hwy. 427 at Plantation Court and Bluff Road at Hwy. 427.
