DONALDSONVILLE – Ascension Parish President Tommy Martinez announced Wednesday the Parish of Ascension Recreation and Culture Department will hold Major League Baseball's Pitch, Hit and Run (PHR) competition on Saturday, May 11, 2013 at 10 a.m. at the South Louisiana Fairgrounds.

The PHR competition is a free, one-day event for boys and girls ages 7-14. Boys and girls compete separately and participants have the opportunity to compete in four levels of competition including Locals, Sectionals, Team Championships and the National Finals at the MLB All-Star Game.

Prizes and awards will be given at each level of competition and competitors will receive an item for their participation. Prizes at different levels of competition include certificates, medals, trophies and other awards. National Finalists will receive a trip to the All-Star Game.
