## **Ascension Parish Storm Debris Pick-Up Schedule Released**

GONZALES –Ascension Parish President Tommy Martinez announced Monday the parish’s debris removal schedule is as follows:

### Zone 1 North West Crew 1

1. All streets west of I-10 starting at south end of 928 and working north to Perkins.
2. All streets north along Perkins to Old Jefferson Highway.
3. All streets south along Perkins to Old Jefferson Highway

### Zone 2 North East Crew 2

1. All streets north along 42 to 431.
2. All streets east along 431 to 931.
3. All streets south of intersection of 431/931

### Zone 3 South West Crew 3

1. All streets on 943.
2. All streets on 944 to 1
3. All streets on 405 from 1 to parish line.
4. All streets on 308 to 945.

### Zone 4 South East Crew 4

1. All streets south of I-10 to 22.
2. All streets south of I-10 from 22 to 44.

### 3. All street along 22 from I-10 to 61 (Sorrento)

If debris removal crews encounter debris piles that are too large, those addresses will be given to crews handling large debris piles and will be picked up the following day.

If crews encounter debris piles that can be hand-picked, those addresses will be given to crews handling small debris piles and will be picked up the following day.

The debris must be placed at the street right-of-way. Officials said **do not** place the debris in ditches, or near mailboxes, fire hydrants, electrical power lines, telephone pedestals or gas meters.

Debris that is placed farther than 10 feet from the street or curb is considered on private property and will not be picked up. Debris should not block the roadway.

A public drop off point will also be established and publicized later this week, said Rick Webre, director of the Ascension Parish Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness.

This service will be for Ascension Parish residents only. Contractors or other commercial vendors will not be allowed to use the designated site.
