Roof Repair Program Sign-Up Period Aug. 17 - Oct. 1

GONZALES – Ascension Parish President Tommy Martinez announced this week sign-up forms will be available until Oct. 1, 2015 for homeowners in Ascension Parish whose roofs suffered damage as a result of Hurricane Gustav and /or Hurricane Ike and desire to have their roofs repaired.

Ascension Parish Government is kicking off its Roof Repair Program next week with two informational meetings slated for Aug. 17 and Aug. 24 in the parish, officials said. The roofing program will be offering qualified households up to \$15,000 in Community Block Grant Funding to have their roofs repaired or replaced.

Residents are encouraged to attend one of the two informational meetings to gain more information. All interested Ascension Parish homeowners will need to sign up within a 45-day period that begins after the first public meeting, making the deadline to indicate interest in the program Oct. 1, 2015.

Sign-up forms will be available at the two informational meetings.

In addition, municipal sites across the parish will have sign-up forms available at their offices for residents unable to attend any of the informational meetings. The sign-up forms will be available to residents starting Aug. 18 at the following sites:
