Sorrento Road Closure Announced

SORRENTO– Ascension Parish President Tommy Martinez announced Monday Main Street in Sorrento will be closed to through traffic so parish drainage crews can install drainage culverts at a specified location.

Main Street will be closed at 7102 Main Street starting Monday, Sept. 16 at 8 a.m. and reopen on Thursday, Sept. 19 at 4 p.m.

Parish drainage officials said crews will install 64 feet of 42-inch culverts at that location to help drain flood waters across Main Street toward a pumping location along the protection levee at Bayou Conway.

Officials said crews will also install two control valves, one at a culvert crossing at John LeBlanc Boulevard and Main Street, and the other at the extension of Main Street by Bayou Conway.

Main Street will be accessible at both intersections with John LeBlanc Boulevard.
